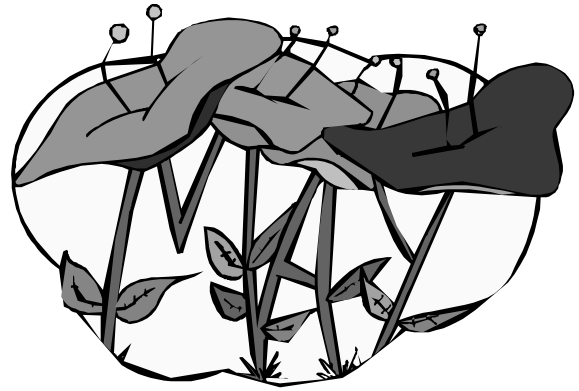
Green reusable tote bags
